Other Uniform Concerns

Shoes

Students must wear **closed-toe shoes** at all times.
Heels of shoes may only be 1-inch or less.

Hats

There are no restrictions on specific hats, but they may be worn only outdoors.

Consequences for Being Out of Uniform

Parents will be notified if their child is out of uniform. Student may be required to remain in the office until appropriate uniform is brought to campus.

Repeated violations may result in disciplinary action including suspension.

Exceptions from Uniform Policy on Spirit Days:

In place of their uniform shirts, students may wear NMIS Spirit T-Shirts on Spirit Days. Spirit T-Shirts may be available for purchase from the Special Events Committee on or before various Spirit Days. Uniform bottoms are still required.
